



WALKING THE ROUTE

Walk 1 – Yatton Railway Station to Congresbury Fishery Lakes and return – approx. 5 miles.

Walk 2 – Yatton Railway Station to Winscombe Old Station Millennium Green and return – approx. 13 miles.

Walk 3 – Yatton Railway Station to Axbridge (turn at picnic tables overlooking Yacht Club and Reservoir) and return – approx. 20 miles.

The route is along the beautiful Strawberry Line and is mainly along footpaths.

SAFETY

WALKERS SHOULD STAY ON DESIGNATED ROUTE.

WALKERS SHOULD DISPLAY NUMBERS (received with information pack). THIS HELPS US TO KEEP TRACK OF YOU IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY.

WALKERS SHOULD BEWARE OF CYCLISTS (THE STRAWBERRY LINE IS BUSY WITH CYCLISTS ON A SUNDAY).

A GOOD TORCH IS REQUIRED FOR SHUTE SHELVE TUNNEL. WALK 3 ONLY.

WALKERS SHOULD TAKE SPECIAL CARE WHEN CROSSING MAIN ROADS (CHILDREN UNDER 16 CAN ONLY CROSS UNDER ADULT INSTRUCTION) AT THE FOLLOWING LOCATIONS:

A370 CONGRESBURY

A38 SHUTE SHELVE

A371 JUNCTION INTO AXBRIDGE VILLAGE.
