ABOUT THE WALK: *The route is along the beautiful Strawberry Line and is mainly along footpaths. There are various length walks available to suit all ages and abilities.*

WALK 1 – Yatton to Congresbury Fishing Lakes Café and return – 5 miles

WALK 2 – Yatton to Winscombe (*Millennium Green*) and return – 13 miles

WALK 3 – Yatton to Axbridge and return – 20 miles

We will provide you with a map and information pack on entry and refreshment stops will be available along the route. Please make sure that you wear appropriate clothing i.e. waterproofs, sun hat, sun block depending on the weather and that one member of your party is carrying a mobile phone. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at the start and finish and anywhere en-route where there are cattle and sheep nearby.

- There is an entrance fee of £5 per adult (children under 11 free of charge) or £10 a team which should accompany this application.

NOTE: All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

START: Start at 9 – 11am from Yatton Railway Station for all the Walks
