WALK INFORMATION SHEET



Yeo Valley Lions is pleased to welcome you to the 10th Strawberry Lion 50:50 sponsored walk. This is another opportunity for you to raise funds for the charity or community club of your choice and additionally to help Yeo Valley Lions raise funds for *The Young Carers Service*. Thank you for your support.

This information pack includes walk information, number and map with route description.

WALK INFORMATION (Should be read with map and route description)

Registration and start:

Please give your name and number at the Registration Points (Lions tables) at west side of Yatton Railway Station. You may start your walk at any time between 9.00am and 11.00am. Axbridge walkers should start at 9.00am prompt as the estimated time to complete the distance is 8 hours.

Finish:

Please go to the Lions table on the west side of Yatton Railway Station to receive your certificate of completion. Refreshments will be available for purchase at the Strawberry Line Café.

Sponsorship Money:

When you have collected your money from the sponsors, please send a minimum of 50% of it together with a copy of your sponsorship form to Yeo Valley Lions Club c/o Roger Gibbins, 6 Edward Road, Clevedon, BS21 7DP.

- ❖ Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- ❖ Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at the start and finish and anywhere on the route where there are cattle and sheep nearby.
- ❖ Wear appropriate clothing i.e. waterproofs, sun hat, sunblock, and good walking shoes.
- ❖ Individual walkers or one member of a group of walkers should carry a mobile phone (this is important) in the event of an emergency.
- ❖ Those retiring from the Walk must inform the nearest checkpoint. This will enable us to monitor walkers who have not yet finished.
- ❖ The Lions minibus will be provided for 'emergency' transport only.
- ❖ Walkers undertaking walks 2 and 3 are advised to carry basic first aid items e.g. blister plasters, etc. Checkpoints will not have first aid facilities but a first aider will be on call.
- ❖ Leave nothing but footprints and take nothing but photographs: please respect the countryside and leave it tidy.

Bad Weather: If weather conditions are poor on the day, please check the walk is still on by phoning Roger Gibbins (01275 874875/07788 646050)
